Completing weekly Homework Sheets Doing a sensory activity once a week with your child (*ideas are given in your child's Homework Book*) Reading with your child each day Talking to your child about the world around them and encourage their exploration

In Speech and Language:

Children will have group Speech and Language sessions 3 times a week within the classroom, in line with their EHCP targets

 In Literacy we will be: Learning Phase 2 phonemes and practising segmenting and blending CVC words. Learning Phase 3 phonemes (digraphs and trigraphs) and blending CVC, CVCC and CCVC words. Continue to use our phonics knowledge to write either initial sounds, simple words or short sentences. Focussing on tracing, copying or forming letters correctly. Listening, engaging and responding to storytelling 	 In Maths we will be exploring Place Value by: Counting, comparing and exploring different representations of numbers Counting forwards and backwards on number lines Comparing numbers by 'fewer, more, same' and then by 'less than, greater than, equal to' In Maths we will also explore: Part-whole models and number bonds within 10
 In Art, Design and Technology we will be: Exploring colour, looking at what the Primary, Secondary and Neutral colours are and how we can mix them to create Tints, Shade and artwork that displays warm and cool colours. Exploring different artwork that focuses on use of colour from a variety of artists such as, Piet Mondrian, Mark Rothko, Paul Klee and many others.
