History & Literacy: The Golden Age

We are traveling back thousands of years to Ancient Egypt! Our focus will be on the "Boy King," Tutankhamun.

- In History: We'll explore the discovery of his tomb and what life was like along the Nile.
- In Literacy: We are reading *The Story of Tutankhamun* to inspire our own historical narratives and reports.

Phonics Focus

We are sharpening our reading and spelling skills by revisiting and mastering Tricky Words across several phases:

- Phases 2 & 3; Phases 4 & 5: Tackling more complex patterns and irregular words to boost our reading fluency.

Mathematics: Real-World Skills

This term is all about practical application and building speed:

- Money: Identifying coins and notes, calculating change, and understanding value.
- Multiplication & Division.

Science: The Body in Motion

Our budding scientists will be looking inward! We are studying the Human Skeleton and Muscles.

- We'll learn how our bones protect us and how muscles work in pairs to help us move, jump, and play.

Art: Patterns, Moods, and Masters

Our art studio is going to be very busy! We are exploring Printing and Painting with a focus on:

- Pattern & Symmetry: Creating intricate repeating patterns inspired by M.C. Escher and Bridget Riley.
- Emotion & Mood: Using color and line to show how people feel, studying the abstract styles of Joan Miró and Paul Klee.
- Key Learning Goal: "I can create a repeating pattern in print and show how people feel in my drawings."
