Our Learning this Half Term

Core Literacy text:

'Where the Forest Meets the Sea' by Jeannie Baker

World Learning:

Geography - Rainforests



In English, we will:

Use conjunctions in our sentences.

Use adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

Use present progressive tense using suffix 'ing'. Write sentences using a variety of punctuation.

Write using our known sounds.

Write in past tense using regular verbs (ed suffix) and irregular verbs.

Write a diary entry and post card.

Write a descriptive setting.

Write a persuasive letter.

Write a explanation texts on a life cycle of a tree.

Write a recount using past tense and adverb of time.

In **RE** we will:

Learn about the symbols of Easter and what they represent.

Learn about the story of Jesus' death and resurrection and what this means to Christians. Learn about the story of Jesus washing feet and sharing food with his friend and what this represents.

In **Computing** we will:

Learn about algorithms and how programs are made.

Create our own basic programs using Scratch Junior.

In **Science** our topic will be Plants 'Growing Things'. We will be: -

Explore outside and look at plants growing. Identify common wild and garden plants.

Identify deciduous and evergreen trees.

Describe the structure of a flowering plants and name the parts.

Plants seeds and find out what plants need to arow.

Observe how seeds and bulbs grow.

In Maths we will:

Count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.

Double and halve numbers

Share and group.

Odd and even numbers.

Divide by 2 and 10.

Problem-solve and reason.

Measure length and height using nonstandard and standard measurements.

Compare and order length and heights.

In **PE** we will:

Develop our ball skills.

Begin to use skills in game play.

Roll a ball to hit a target.

Move with a ball.

Start and stop with control.

Throwing and catching with accuracy.

In World Learning we will:

Name and locate rainforests around the world.

Learn about the flora and fauna of the rainforest.

Learn about the structure of the rainforest.

Research the reasons why deforestation occurs and the effects it is having.
Use atlases and globes.

In **Music** we will:

Continue our violin lessons with our amazing music teachers.
