In English, we will be reading the book Escape from Pompeii, by Christina Balit. We will be using powerful verbs to expand sentences to make them more interesting. Making inferences about the characters in the story and ask and answer questions whilst being in role.

In Maths, we will using our base knowledge of Place Value from the previous term to apply them to addition and subtraction calculations and problems and using concrete manipulatives to secure their knowledge and understanding.

In Science, we will we exploring the wonderful world of Rocks. We will be investigating the Geology side of rocks and creating our own documentary surrounding all the different layers, locations and properties of them.

In PSHE, we will be exploring the Jigsaw piece of CELEBRATING DIFFERENCE. We will be busy tackling and understanding issues surrounding bullying during Anti Bullying week and thinking about inclusion within are school, our community and world wide.

In World Learning, we will be going back in time to explore the Roman era. Looking at the importance of their architecture, the significance of the Roman Gods and how they lived day to day life in their communities.

In PE we will developing our Gymnastic skills and working balancing, cartwheels, partner work, sequencing and performance.

In Computing, we will be learning about different devices within our home and what can record sound. We will be aiming to record our own podcasts.

In **RE**, we will be looking at Judaism and the rituals that come with the holy time of Shabbat, who Abraham was, and what other festivals that the Jewish community take part in.
