OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

Our theme this half term is Transport. Some of the books we will be reading are - Car Car Truck Jeep, The Train Ride, The Naughty Bus, My Gumpy's Outing, Maisy goes by Plane and Tractor Book (All Aboard the Busy Tractor). We will also be doing lots of mark making and continue to practice writing our names. In maths these are some of the things we will be looking at - Fast recognition of up to 3 objects, (without having to count them individually, this is called 'subitising'), say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5 and show 'finger numbers' up to 5. We will continue to work on all areas of development as we discussed in our face to face parents meeting.



Continue to read at home, compare stories that you have read and characters from the stories, talk about memories and experiences in your own lives, do lots of counting, talk about colour and shape recognition. Keep it fun and enjoy learning!
