
Spring 2 'Plants and Growing Life' Moonstone Class


Happy Half Term, we hope you had a lovely break!

This term we will be learning about 'Plants and Growing Life', in our



Geography, History, Science and PSED lessons. We will be exploring different types of plants, flowers and trees, what they need to make them grow and what different parts they have. We will be looking at minibeasts, different species and where we might find them. We will also look at ourselves and how we change and grow throughout our lives from babies to adults as part of our PSED learning. To support our learning about growing and changing life, we will be looking at 'Jack and the Beanstalk', 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and 'The Enormous Turnip' in our Literacy lessons.

You can help your child at home by: Talking about different types of plants and flowers you can see near your home, are they big, small, what colour are they, do they smell, how many leaves do they have? etc. Talking about different types of minibeasts and insects you can see near your home, how big/small are they, how many legs, do they have wings etc. Different types of 2D shapes Practising making ABAB patterns Reading with your child each day. In Literacy we will be:

- Learning Phase 2 phonemes and practising matching initial sounds to pictures
- Learning Phase 3 phonemes such as, ai, ee, igh (digraphs and trigraphs)
- Continue to use our phonics knowledge to write simple words such as, CVC words like sheep and boat.
- Focussing on forming letters correctly.
- Listening to a range of books and discussing what has happened, answering and asking questions about them.

In computing we will be learning:

In Maths we will be:

- Exploring and recognising different 2D shapes
- Exploring and recognising different 3D shapes
- Exploring and creating shape patterns
- Exploring and creating ABAB patterns
