Summer 2 'Ocean Life' Moonstone Class

Hope you had a good half term break! This term we will be learning about life within our oceans, in our Geography,



History and Science lessons. In Literacy we will be:

- Learning Phase 2 phonemes and practising matching initial sounds to pictures
- Learning Phase 3 phonemes such as, ai, ee, igh (digraphs and trigraphs)
- Continue to use our phonics knowledge to write simple words such as, CVC words like sheep and boat.
- Focussing on forming letters correctly.
- Listening to a range of books and discussing what has happened, answering and asking questions about them.

Expressive arts and design Art, Design and Technology:

We will be:

Using different types of materials to make our own animals that live on the Great Barrier Reef. We will explore different artwork of marine life from different artists, such as Jenny Berry. Developing our pencil grip by exploring real-life drawing of marine life and be able to become more independent artists.

World Learning:

In Science will be learning about:

- Marine life, different types of animals and sea plants we might find in different oceans
- Exploring the season of summer and the changes our environment goes through

In Geography we will be learning about:

- The five key oceans, their differences and what types of life is found in each of them
- The importance of keeping our oceans clean

In History we will be learning about:

 Pirates, their lives, their ships, key items and objects linked to them

In R.E we will carry on learning about:

Islam

In computing we will be learning:

- to programme robots to follow instructions
- use computers safely and carefully

In Maths we will be:

- Exploring multiplying in twos.
- Exploring multiplying in fives.
- Exploring multiplying in tens.
- Exploring fractions
- Exploring money
- Carry on exploring different measurements of time

Music:

Children will carry on with violin lessons each week where they will learn simple rhythm and patterns through songs and learn how to correctly hold and use the violin.
