In Literacy we will be:

- Recap Phase 2 sounds
- Learn new sounds
- Listen to sounds around us
- Trace our names
- Use known sounds to trace initial sound
- Say the sounds that we are practicing
- Developing pencil grip
- Listen to a range of books and discuss what has happened

In Maths we will be:

- Develop our counting skills
- Count up to 5 forwards and backwards
- Count objects within 5 with 1:1 correspondence
- Subitise up to 5
- Use counting to find how many objects there are in a set

In Arts and Design we will:

- Make our own poppies
- Draw a hedgehog
- · Create a snow forest scene
- · Make a Christmas ornament

In RE we will:

In P.E we will be:

- Develop our fine motor through activities that strengthen our hand muscles
