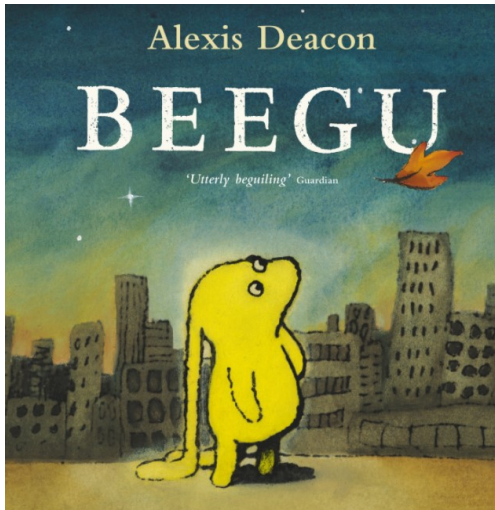

All About Me



Welcome to the year 1! This term we will be transitioning to year 1 and our topic is 'All About Me'. As part of our learning, we will be reading the texts "Ruby's Worries", "Super Duper You" and "Beegu". We will be talking about our feelings, what makes us unique and our families. "Beegu" will be coming to visit us soon—look out for "Beegu's" spaceship landing in Jubilee!

The STAR words are the key vocabulary the children will learn, understand and be able to use by the end of the term are:

emotions feelings

same different

likes dislikes

special unique

family friends

nationality

You can help your child by:

- talking about who is in their family, who their friends are and what makes them special.
- talking about how they are feeling and why.

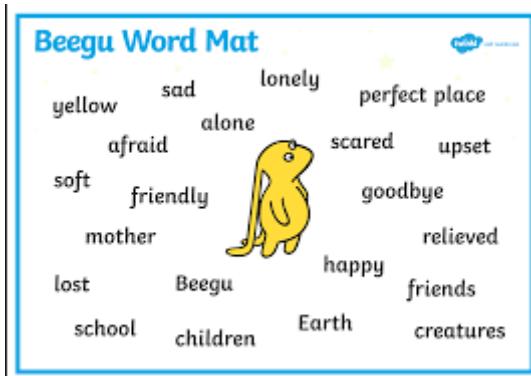
Key messages:

In English we will be:

-Reading 'Ruby's Worry' and exploring and talking about our feelings.

-Writing about ourselves and our family.

Reading 'Super Duper You' and writing about how we are special.

-Reading the story 'Beegu' (please do not read the book to the children just yet, it's a surprise!).

-Re-enacting the story in order to retell and sequence the events.

-Using adjectives to describe the characters and setting.

-Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops

In Topic we will be:

-talking and thinking about facts about ourselves
-what we like/dislike, our families, what we look like.

-learning about the different countries we are from.

-learning how we are similar to and different to our friends.

-learning about the different groups we belong to.

-thinking about how we have changed since we were a baby (please email a baby picture for our class display to the school email address - admin@jubilee.lambeth.sch.uk).

In Music, with our Music Masters teachers we will be:

-learning how to handle the violin safely and starting to make sounds in different ways.

We will be having weekly group and paired sessions. Our violin lessons are on Monday and Thursday for both classes.

-Working together to make our class charter.

-Working as a team.

In Science, we will be learning:

-To identify internal and external parts of the body and how they work to keep us alive.

-To monitor effects and changes to our bodies with different activities.

-Different animal groups as well as humans.

In Art we will be:

-Designing and using clay to make models.

-Looking at similarities and differences between different artists.

-Drawing what we see to create self-portraits.

-Mixing colours and review-

In ICT we will be:

-Learning all about E-safety and how we can make sure we stay safe online. .
