### Ideas for home learning


- Create a picture or collage of your dream holiday.

## Our IPC topic this term is: 'Hooray! Let's go on holiday!'

## In English we will be reading Gregory Cool and Nim's Island.

#### We will be:

- Comparing characters and settings.
- Making predictions.
- Writing:
  - O Emails and social media posts;
  - O Diary entries;
  - O Postcards and letters;
  - O Persuasive adverts; and
  - O Narratives
- We will continue revising all Year 2 learning objectives and introducing apostrophes for possession and contraction.

# In Maths we will be developing our understanding of multiplication, division and fractions.

#### We will:

- Revisit multiplication and division.
  - O Recognise and make equal groups.
  - Make equal groups from a whole amount using sharing and grouping.
  - Use the x and ÷ symbols.
  - Use our skills to reason and solve problems.
- Learn how to find fractions of shapes and amounts.
  - O Recognise and write 1/2, 1/3, 1/4 and 3/4.
  - Count in fractions.

# In Topic we will be learning about holidays. We will:

- Visit the Jubilee Passport Office to find out why we need passports and create our own.
- Think about why we go on holiday.
- Explore different ways of travelling abroad.
- Find out what happens at the airport.
- Learn about and compare different types of holiday.
- Explore a range of holiday destinations in the UK and abroad.
- Find out about holidays from the past.
- Create holiday themed art, including railway seaside destination posters.

## In Science we will be completing some additional lessons to further our learning from this year about:

- Animals
- Habitats
- Everyday materials
- Plants

### In Computing we will be learning to create presentations using PowerPoint.

## We will:

- Create slide decks.
- Add information about a given topic.
- Include pictures and videos.

### In RE we will be learning about Islam.

#### We will:

- Find out about The Mosque as a place of worship.
  - Explore the design and use of The Mosque.
  - Learn about how people worship.

# In PE we will be playing rounders.

#### We will:

- Learn the rules of the game.
- Develop our throwing and catching skills.
- Work cooperatively in teams.
