

Curriculum Newsletter Year 6 Spring Term Time Detectives

In <u>English</u> we will be continuing to explore the text:

The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne. We will:

- Write in role by making inferences about characters' speech and actions.
- Rewrite chapters from alternate perspectives
- Create a new ending

In <u>Science</u> we will be learning about light and shadow:

- Think about how light travels in straight lines
- Understand key vocabulary like: transparent, translucent and opaque
- Understand reflection
- Investigate light and shadow

In **RE** we will be developing our knowledge of Justice and Freedom by:

- They will learn how key figures in historysuch as Martin Luther King and Aung San Suu Kyi were informed and influenced by their own religious beliefs.
- They will examine the impact of different religious and non-religious ideas about the formation of the Non-Violent Protest and Human Rights Movements.

In Music we will be:

- Learning how to use our voice in a range of ways.
- Exploring melodies, harmonies and rhythms.

In Spanish we will be learning how to:

- Look at vocabulary linked to space
- Revise colour and shapes

In <u>PE</u> we will be learning about athletics. We will be:

- Practising sprints

- Securing our knowledge in algebra
- Securing our knowledge in ratio and proportion

- Continuing with the recovery curriculum

- Use key words and phrases in regards to the passing of time
- Compare our lives with those of people from the past
- Create a timeline
- Relate events in history to our local area
