Our learning

This term's IPC topic is 'Our World' and our Science topic is 'Plants'. We will be learning about the Earth and how we can look after it by doing things like recycling, conserving water and protecting wildlife.

In English, we will be exploring the texts 'The Journey Home' by Frann Preston Gannon and 'Clean Up!' by Nathan Bryon and Dapo Adeola. We will be learning to use different grammatical features and to write for a variety of purposes including producing non-chronological reports and persuasive letters.

In English, through our core text, we will:

- Revise the four sentence types.
- Describe using expanded noun phrases.
- Use co-ordinating (and, but, or, so) and subordinating (because, when, if) conjunctions to add detail.
- Add suffixes –ing and –ed to verbs to show tense.
- Begin to use commas in lists
- Develop our inference skills.
- Plan, edit and publish pieces of writing.
- Write for a range of purposes.

In IPC Topic, we learn about how to keep our world safe by:

- Reducing, reusing and recycling products
- Conserving water
- Protecting wildlife

In Maths, we will:

- Secure our understanding of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Continue to practice multiplying amounts by 2, 5 10.
- Learn to divide using our existing knowledge.
- Recognise how to perform the inverse operation to solve calculations.
- Use mathematical vocabulary.
- Solve problems about multiplication and division.
- Develop our reasoning skills.

In Science, we will find out about plants by:

- Identifying the different parts of a plant.
- Learning what plants need to grow.
- Observing plants over time.
- Comparing how bulbs and seeds grow.
- Exploring the plants we eat.
- Learning about the plant life cycle.

In Computing, we will learn about data handling by:

- Inputting data
- Choosing different charts
- Recording information from different lessons.
- Presenting data in different ways.

In PE, we will:

- Develop our listening, balance and co-ordination.
- Work co-operatively with a partner and as part of a team.

In RE, we will learn about prayer in Islam:

- Explore how people pray.
- Find out about daily prayers.
- Learn about where people pray.
