

Welcome to Year 3! This term we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians through the topic 'Temples, Tombs and Treasures'. The people who helped create the first great civilisations were not unlike you and me. Today we can learn a lot about these people and their way of life through the things they left behind – from everyday objects to magnificent and rare treasures. As part of the topic we will be reading The story of Tutankhamun by Patricia Cleveland-Peck. As part of our entry point the children will become archaeologists and 'dig' for ancient ruins.

In Maths we will:

Develop our understanding of place value of up to three-digit numbers.

Identify, represent and estimate numbers in different ways. Compare and order numbers up to 1000.

Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.

Add and subtract numbers mentally.

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits using formal written methods.

Solve number and practical problems using number facts and place value.

Develop our reasoning skills.

In Science we will learn about *Light*.

We will:

Learn about light and understand darkness as the absence of light.

Investigate how shadows are made and changed.

Discover how light reflects and different reflective surfaces.

Explore how mirrors work.

Plan a simple enquiry then record and present our findings.

In Computing we will:

Learn about how we can stay safe and make good choices online.

Use search engines and communication tools.

In RE we will:


Learn about Islam.

Develop our understanding of the worship and festivals of other faiths.

In Music we will:

Learn to play the recorder, glockenspiel and Djembe drums.

Learn about beat, rhythm and tempo.



Our topic for this term is:

We will:

Explore what life was like in Ancient Egypt.

Learn about Ancient Egyptian gods and beliefs about the afterlife.

Understand the process of mummification.

Discover the significance of pharaohs like Tutankhamun, and what can be learnt from their tombs.
