Welcome to year 4! Our topic this term is Anglo-Saxon. As part of this topic this term, we will be learning about the history of the Anglo-Saxons, researching where they originated from and why they decided to settle in Brittan. We will be looking into how they lived daily and the laws they lived by.

The children will become mini arachnologists and help identify artefact from the Anglo-Saxon era, finding out what recourses they used to survive.

The Goldilocks words are the key vocabulary the children will learn, understand and be able to use by the end of the topic. They are called Goldilocks words as they are not too easy, not too hard, but just right!
