Welcome to Spring 1 in year 5! Our topic this term is Bake It. As part of our topic, we will be exploring the science topic: Properties and Changes of Materials. Children will explore changes in different materials through a variety of experiments and cooking activities. What has cooking got to do with science? Cooking involves many scientific processes such as combining, dissolving, heating and cooling materials to create physical and chemical changes, to the extent that cooking could more accurately be called chemistry! To further develop their investigative skills, children will read and explore the book 'Tuesday' by David Wiesner. Children will be developing their language and vocabulary by completing writing tasks such as a police incident report, newspaper article and descriptive setting.
