In <u>English</u> we will be exploring the text *The adventures of the new cut gang by Philip Pull-man* We will be:

- Contrasting school life then and new and writing diary entries
- Writing a newspaper report to both inform and entertain, using direct and reported speech.
- Writing short narratives, focusing on creating a mystery that needs to be solved.

We will also be doing daily SPaG sessions focusing on word class (nouns, adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions, verbs, prepositions and determiners) this term.

In <u>Computing</u> we will be:

- Refreshing our knowledge of e-safety and communication.
- Focusing on how to be safe and sensible when using mobile devices.

In <u>Science</u> we will be learning about Light and Electricity:

- Investigate the effect of cells
- Create a scientific diagram
- Plan an investigation to test the effects of changing a component.

In <u>PE</u> we will be learning about Basketball

- Practising passing
- Practising dribbling
- Learning how to shot both set shots and lay up
- Developing team work skills.

In Music we will be:

- Learning how to use our voice in a range of ways.
- Exploring melodies, harmonies and rhythms.

In Maths we will be:

- Learning about place value by multiplying and dividing by powers of 10.
- Developing our use of the formal written methods for different calculations.
- Applying the formal calculation methods to solve multi-step problems in context.
- Applying number facts to help improve our mental calculation strategies.

We will also have weekly arithmetic sessions.
