
# Curriculum Newsletter Year 6 Autumn Term Victorians





Welcome to Year 6! Our topic this term is The Victorians. The children will be finding out about life in Victorian Britain, focusing on schools, work houses, the expansion of the railway and the industrial revolution. Our key text this half term will be *The Adventures of the New Cut Gang* by Phillip Pullman. We will delve into the themes presented in this narrative genre related to creating mystery and suspense in the book and will employ these skills in our writing. In <u>English</u> we will be exploring the text *The* adventures of the new cut gang by Philip Pullman We will be:

- Contrasting school life then and new and writing diary entries
- Writing a newspaper report to both inform and entertain, using direct and reported speech.
- Writing short narratives, focusing on creating a mystery that needs to be solved.

We will also be doing daily SPaG sessions focusing on word class (nouns, adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions, verbs, prepositions and determiners) this term.

#### In Maths we will be:

- Learning about place value by multiplying and dividing by powers of 10.
- Developing our use of the formal written methods for different calculations.
- Applying the formal calculation methods to solve multi-step problems in context.
- Applying number facts to help improve our mental calculation strategies.

We will also have weekly arithmetic sessions.

#### In **Computing** we will be:

- Refreshing our knowledge of e-safety and communication.
- Focusing on how to be safe and sensible when using mobile devices.

In <u>Science</u> we will be learning about Light and Electricity:

- Investigate the effect of cells
- Create a scientific diagram
- Plan an investigation to test the effects of changing a component.

In <u>PE</u> we will be learning about Tag Rugby

- Practising defending
- Practising attacking
- Practising agility and awareness of opponents.
- Learning the correct passes.
