Welcome to Year 6!

In <u>English</u> we will be exploring the text Otto by Tom Ungerer

- Write in role by making inferences about characters' speech and actions.
- Create character's voice and write in role informally.
- Write an auto biography about Sam king,
 Billy Strachan or Violet Szabo.

In <u>Science</u> we will be learning about how the human body works and the functions of our organs:

- the role of blood in our body.
- the role of blood to transport oxygen around the body.
- how water and nutrients are transported around the body.

In **PE** we will be learning about Hockey the skills we will be learning are:

- Passing the ball
- Dribbling and agility
- Working as a team to score and defend.

In **Topic** we will be:

- Use key words and phrases in regards to the passing of time
- Compare our lives with those of people from the past
- Create a timeline
- Relate events in history to our local area

In <u>Maths</u> we will be focusing on geometry, statistics and measures. We will be:
