The Mayan Civilisation



Welcome to year 4! Our topic this term is The Mayan Civilisation. As part of this topic we will be reading the Ancient Mayan myth, "The Hero Twins". The children, having touched on the subject as part of the previous topic, Chocolate. The topic will commence with the children mixing and tasting a chocolate drink such as the Mayans may have drunk (not the sweet, hot chocolate we may be familiar with today in London)! Also, year 4 will be benefiting from professional cricket coaching, as well as athletics taught by class teachers. This term, 4DO will be sharing our learning at the end of term.

The Goldilocks words are the key vocabulary the children will learn, understand and be able to use by the end of the topic. They are called Goldilocks words as they are not too easy, not too hard, but just right!

Visit the British Museum website to see some Ancient Mayan artefacts.

Find and read other Mayan myths.

In Maths we will be:

- Continue using the column method to add and subtract.
- Explore measurements and different units of measure- focusing on length.
- Use our understanding of length to measure and record perimeters of shapes and objects.
- Begin multiplying numbers by 10 and 100.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and addition.

In English we will be:

Reading the Mayan Legend – The Hero Twins.
Summarising the information from the text.
Continuing to write in paragraphs, use fronted adverbials and to use expanded noun phrases.

In Computing we will be:

- Program in logo to create more complex algorithms
Children to investigate using repeat to create loops.

In PE we will be:

Developing athletic skills: speed walking, jumping, sprinting, relays and throwing.

In Science we will be:

- learning about electricity.
- learning about electrical and non-electrical appliances.
- explaining how circuits work.
- naming conductors and insulators and creating our own simple circuits including some with a switch.

about Mayan gods and religious ceremonies.
about their number system and how it compares to ours.
about their diet and how it differs from ours?
