### Food



In Communication and Language we will be:

- Listening to and identifying different sounds.
- Joining in with stories.
- Beginning to show our understanding when using "who, what and where" questions.

*You can help your child by pointing out different sounds you can hear in different places, encouraging your child to identify the sounds and make them yourselves.*

In Maths we will be:

- Learning that numbers identify how many objects are in a set.
- Learning to match numeral and quantity.
- Finding numerals in the environment.
- Beginning to start writing numbers.
- Beginning to talk about the shapes of everyday objects, e.g. 'round' and 'tall'.

*You can help your child's learning by identifying numbers you see around you, such as numbers on a bus or on your front door. You can also count food together and identify the amount you they have. You can also help them by talking about the*

In Understanding of the World we will be:

- Finding out about different occupations and ways of life.
- Learning about food and where it comes from around the world.
- Talking about special times we remember for ourselves and our families.

*You can help your child's learning by talking*

In Physical development we will be:

- Exploring different ways of moving, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, sliding and hopping.
- Developing skills when using one-handed tools and equipment, learning how to use them safely.
- Learning how to copy letters from our name.
- Learning to be more independent in our own care.

In Literacy we will be:

- Retelling stories using our own words
- Thinking about how a story might end.
- Learning to describe main story settings, events and principal characters.
- Learning to write our own names

*You can help your child's learning by sharing books with them regularly at*

In PSED we will be:

- Learning to listen to the ideas of others and give our own.
- Beginning to have conversations with each other and with adults
- Share resources and take turns
- Begin to take responsibility for helping with small tasks.
- Beginning to think about how are actions affect other

*You can help your child's learning by talking about friends, playing games involving taking turns, and the importance of helping others.*

In Expressive arts and design we will be:

- Exploring and learning how sounds and colours can be changed.
- Investigating and describing the texture of things.
- Making up stories around our toys.

*You can help your child's learning by making up songs about what you are doing and talking about how different objects feel*
