Trips and Visits

<u>Reception Monty and Co Visit</u> Reception had a real treat on Friday when Monty, the star of a new programme called Monty and Co came in for a visit. They watched one of the programmes and learnt a lot about puppets and puppet making.

Year 4 Wetland Centre Year 4 attended a workshop on leaf classification searching for leaves to match up with their classification charts. They particularly enjoyed spotting interesting pieces on the Lego Wildlife trail and were lucky enough to observe a family of Otters!

Year 4 Violin BFI Performance Jubilee Primary's Year 4 violinists had a great time performing their own compositions for the sound track to animated short films as part of the BFI Film Festival at the BFI on the Southbank. It was a memorable experience and they learnt what a difficult, but enjoyable, skill providing soundtrack to film really is.

Year 5 Southbank Centre On Friday 19th October, Year 5 visited the Southbank Learning Centre to take part in a Greek Myths Workshop. Throughout the session, children created their own stories. Finally children worked in groups of 10 to build their very own monsters!

Year 5 British Museum As part of their "The great the **bold and the brave" topic, Year 5** explored the Parthenon Galleries. Children were given tablets to locate symbols, statues and sculptors around this section of the museum. The challenge task was self-led and children worked exceptionally well in pairs to locate the missing clues, completing 4 challenging levels.

Year 6 Wetland Centre As an entry point to their Out of Africa topic, Year 6 also visited the Wetland Centre last week. They took part in pond dipping and looked at the lifecycles and adaptations of different creatures.

Nana Frimpong Tournament Jubilee's footballers narrowly missed out on a first trophy of the season, finishing in 3rd place. We lost out to a last minute winner in the semi finals. Following on from this we completed two more league fixtures beating Vauxhall 4 nil before coming back to earth with a bump in a 8 nil defeat against a very strong Hillmead team. <u>LEAP Building</u> Building work is due to begin soon in order to create a new room for the Children's Centre. This will create space for parents, health professionals and children under five. The new space will directly connect to the existing Children's Centre via a covered walkway.

This work is being funded by LEAP - Lambeth Early Action Partnership - who have secured funding from the Big Lottery Fund for 10 years to improve services for pregnant women and children up to their 4th birthday.

The availability of car parking may be limited during the building works. However there may be availability of parking spaces on the other side of the school, adjacent to Purser House

We are really pleased that, after years of planning this exciting project is getting underway and will continue to keep you posted of developments as the work gets underway.
