SCHOOL BOOK FAIR **Friday, 4th October 2.30 – 3.45 p.m.**

We try to encourage the children to read in many ways, and we feel that a book fair is a good way to promote reading for pleasure. The leaflet your child has lists a sample of the books which will be on sale. (The choice is much bigger at the sale). The price of the books start at £2.99. The children will be told that there is **no obligation to buy** and that they shouldn't pester you!

The books are roughly graded in different cases and we also have books by award winning authors for different age groups. There will be posters and a stationery selection with bookmarks, notepads, pens etc. starting at 50p.

HOW CAN YOU BUY BOOKS?

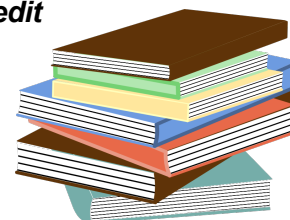
- **COME TO THE SALE**

From 2.30 pm on Friday 4th October, you may take your child from the class and look at the books together. There is usually quite a crush immediately after school, slightly earlier or later is better but please note that children will be expected to leave school at the normal time. ***We can accept debit and credit cards.***

- **YOU CAN ORDER BOOKS**

Look on the website (www.bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk) and the leaflet (there will be much more choice at the actual fair) and send the order slip and money to the School Office - cheques to *Keelby Primary Academy*, in an envelope clearly marked with the child's name.

We will always try and take these books from the shelves on the day of the fair but if we do have to order them they will be delivered within a few days.



- **DOWNLOAD PRE-PAID INTERNET GIFT VOUCHERS**

If you visit www.bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk/parents you can buy pre-paid internet book vouchers for your children to spend or order books.

- **CHILDREN MAY BRING MONEY TO SPEND**

Please make sure money is in an envelope with the child's name and the amount on the outside. If you are not able to attend we will make sure your child has help choosing a book/stationery.

YOU ARE HELPING THE SCHOOL

We can receive up to 60% commission if we sell over £800 of books. This means we could place around £600 worth of books into the library and classrooms. Last year we had an extremely successful Book Fair and we were able to spend £1,000 on books for the school.
