Our aims for remote learning....

- Our remote learning offer will be in line with our in school curriculum offer with teachers dividing their time equally between the two groups
- Our remote learning will set meaningful and ambitious work
- Our remote learning will cover all areas of the curriculum, incorporating knowledge retrieval as well as acquisition of new knowledge
- Our remote learning will include video teaching and online face to face teaching
- Our remote learning will provide learners with quality feedback and enable them to continue to make good progress
- Our remote learning will be made accessible for all
- Our remote learning will provide 3-4 hours learning, daily



How will we deliver quality remote learning?

- Class Dojo will continue to be our main platform for delivering remote learning
- We will post weekly/daily timetables on the class story including the learning overview with links to resources
- The lesson resources will also be uploaded in Portfolio- videos, texts..
- Portfolio is used for pupils to their submit work
- Work will be assigned to the whole class or individuals as needed
- Teachers will make it clear to pupils how they need to complete the work



How will we deliver quality remote learning?

- Children can use the range of response types to complete work in Dojo
- We will schedule some online 'Teams' lessons and social interaction opportunities each week, these will be clearly indicated by icons on the timetable
- Children will receive feedback from teachers in real time during live lessons and via Portfolio when work has been submitted
- Children will be given some opportunities to respond to feedback or make changes to their work in portfolio



How will we deliver quality remote learning?

- Teachers will continue to assess children's learning and address any specific needs accordingly
- Teachers will be available between 9am and 4pm to answer any queries and respond to home learners.
- Ms Cowling is our identified senior leader responsible for the quality of remote learning, please contact her with any issues or if you need any support.
- We will operate a daily checking systems to monitor pupils engagement with home learning and follow up with a phone call if needed.



What are our expectations when learning from home?

- We expect children to approach their learning with the same positive attitude and learning behaviours as in school
- We expect the children to follow the class timetable
- We will provide as much support as we can to help you with your learning
- When participating in live lessons we expect children to follow the schools 'Teams' acceptable user policy
- Parents will remain an important part of the learning team and interact with school regularly
