## English

We will begin the new term reading 'The Emperor's Egg'. We will use this non-fiction book to gain knowledge on this style of genre.

Our written work will focus on writing a setting description, using our previous knowledge of year I and year 2 grammar to continue a high standard of writing.

Once completing a setting description, we will then focus on writing an information text based on a Wonder of the UK. This will link to the children's Geography knowledge.

### Reading

Please continue to share the love of books with your child. Encourage your child to read their Little Wandle book 5 times per week.

We also encourage you to revisit and reread favourite books and stories.

Children will also continue to enjoy a class story where they will deepen their knowledge on retrieval and inference questioning.

Little Wandle books will be changed every Friday.

### Science

This half term Year 2 will be learning about 'Plants'. We will be gaining knowledge of the life cycle of a plant and using experiments to observe and research how plants grow and what they need to stay healthy.

## Curriculum - Geography

This half term in Year 2, our Geography enquiry question will be,

'What are the wonders of the UK?'
We will use geographical vocabulary to compare the UK's human and physical landmarks. We will use our previous knowledge to help us to be able to locate the four countries of the UK and where the landmarks can be found on a map.
