

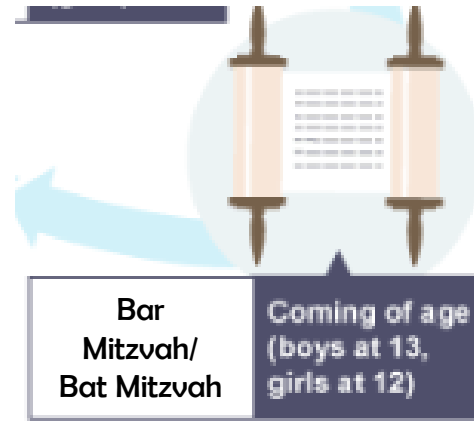
Vocabulary

Rabbi	A Jewish teacher or leader
Torah	The first five books in the old testament
Ner Tamid	a lamp that is set above and in front of the Holy Ark in a synagogue and is kept burning constantly
Synagogue	A synagogue is a building where Jewish people meet to worship
Shema	the central statement of Jewish belief, the sentence " Hear, O Israel: the Lord is your God; the Lord is One"
Hebrew	Traditional Jewish language
Kosher	Something, especially food, that is kosher is approved of or allowed by the laws of Judaism.
Kashrut	The dietary rules of Judaism
Worship	Showing your respect to your God
Eucharist	A service commemorating the Last Supper
Holy Communion	The most important service in the Christian church, with bread and wine
Covenant	An agreement between God and humans

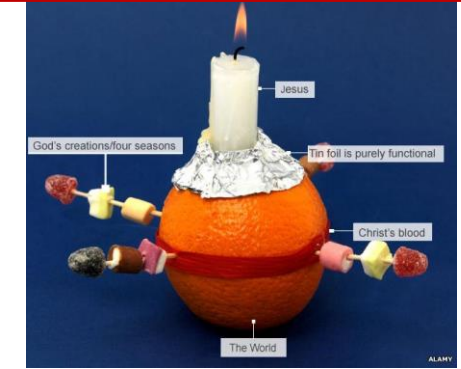

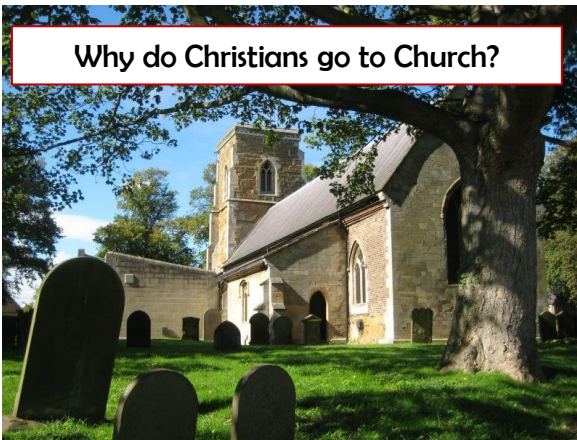
THE TEN COMMANDMENTS For Kids
