 England is divided into counties and each county has its own council.

• We live in the **county** of Lincolnshire.

- North Yorkshire is the largest county.
- Whitby is a seaside town on the east coast of England.



Whitby is in a deep valley on the mouth of the River Esk.





• Whitby is surrounded by the North York Moors.

Moorland is a type of habitat found in upland

landscapes.

• Fossils can be found on the coast around Whitby.

Land use in and around Whitby includes roads, housing, farms, fishing harbours and parks.

Whitby is popular with **tourists** due to beaches, Whitby Abbey and the moorlands.

County – a region within a country with its own local council.

Fossil – the remains of a plant or animal that are found within a rock.

Moorland – an area of open land mainly covered by grass and heather.

<u>Attraction</u> – something that makes people want to go to a place.

Traditional – something that is long established.

<u>Narrow – something that measures a very small distance</u>

from one side to another.

Coastal – describes something near the sea or by a coast.

Cobbled – An area or pathway paved with cobbles.

Harbour – an area of the coast where boats are kept safely.
