
INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS AWARD WEDNESDAY, 6TH JULY

What an exciting term full of international activity! We hope the children have come home full of enthusiasm for the cultural links they have been making with other countries. As part of this award, Mrs White has been busy meeting with various people arranging various activities and she will be going on an exchange to China in October.

On Wednesday, 6th July, between 9.00—11.00 a.m. we will be having a visit from seven Chinese Headteachers and Chris Williams, our British Council Ambassador.



The project, which involves seven Lincolnshire schools, is



called 'Shakespeare Lives' and commemorates the British playwright who was born 400 years ago. Unlike the previous week long visit from Ratan (from Bangladesh), we only have two hours to showcase Keelby Primary Academy, demonstrate our skills and celebrate our successes.

On this occasion we will be opening the school gates at 8.40 a.m. so we have everyone ready to greet

the visitors at 9.00 a.m.. Children will be greeting our visitors, starting from outside the main entrance and continuing into the hall. Whilst they are doing this they will be waving flags and singing a welcome song and then meet the rest of the school in the hall who will also be singing the same song.

There will then be a whole school assembly which you are very welcome to attend (<u>but please arrive before 8.55 a.m. and via the playground</u>). Year 5 pupils will be acting out a scene from 'Macbeth' during assembly. After this the visitors will be having

refreshments, followed by a tour of the school led by our Y6 pupils. The visitors will also be observing teaching and learning around the school. We will complete the visit by giving our guests a demonstration of our line dancing techniques and saying farewell in Chinese.
