- It will help them to feel more confident in school when they can use the toilet independently
- It will also be a great help for them (and for us) if they can take off and put on their coat, jumper and shoes by themselves.
- Your child will be sharing toys with other children, if this is something they haven't needed to do so far then maybe you could get them used to it by sharing their toys with you

Our main focus for these two terms will be personal, social and emotional development, we want them to be happy in school, to enjoy the company of other children, to be able to work and play together and to get used to the rules and routines of our unit.
