EYFS

In the final term of Reception, staff complete an Early Years Foundation Stage Profile (EYFSP) for each child, assessing their development against each of the Early Learning Goals.

Year 1 Phonics Screening

At the end of Year 1, all children take a Phonics Screening Check. This assessment is designed to confirm that they have developed age-appropriate phonic decoding skills. Children who do not yet meet the expected standard will receive additional support to help them strengthen their decoding abilities. They will then have the opportunity to retake the check in Year 2.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of year 4. The MTC's purpose is to ensure the times tables knowledge is at the expected level. The Multiplication Times Tables Check is an online test where the pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12.

Key Stage 2

At the end of Year 6, children complete the Key Stage 2 National Assessments, commonly known as SATs. These government-set tests assess pupils' attainment in maths and English. Children sit formal tests in maths, reading, and in spelling, punctuation, and grammar (often referred to as SPaG).



In addition to the test papers, children's writing is assessed by their class teacher against national standards. This year, our teacher assessments were reviewed and validated by external moderators to ensure accuracy and consistency.
