- Wednesday 2nd September: First day for pupils –*please note that all pupils are expected*
- Our times will continue to be Monday –Thursday: 9.00-3.00 and Friday 9.00-1.30
- In order to minimise the risk of COVID19 we will put each class into bubbles . The pupils will remain in these bubbles for break and lunch time . Break and lunch times will be staggered so that children remain in small groups and do not unnecessarily mix with others. The DfE (Department for Education) guidance states that we need to minimise the number of contacts the pupils have and therefore limit the possibility of infection.
- Over the summer holidays, we will be busy ensuring the building has a deep clean and
 continuing to prepare our curriculum to ensure that we get back to normal teaching and
 learning as soon as we can. I will be preparing a guide for parents & carers and pupils that
 will explain in detail how our new systems will operate. Over the holidays, I will also contact
 you all by phone to see how you are and to answer any questions you may have about your
 child starting back in September.
- If your child is reintegrating back into school –they will need to wear their school uniform at school and a plain white t-shirt for KPA. We can provide a KPA t-shirt if needed. This will ensure that there is limited cross contamination.
- Please ensure your child only brings the minimum to school —a bag (if needed), a phone (if in Y6 and an independent traveller), a packed lunch (if this is usual for them). They should keep unnecessary objects at home.
