#### **PE Hoodies**



Many parents have been enquiring about Hoodies for PE. Bang Bang uniform have agreed to supply PE hoodies to our parents if they wish to purchase them. They will be maroon with the school logo on. The hoodies should be ready to purchse in a weeks time. They can also purchase plain black or navy

blue jogging bottoms for when the weather is colder for outdoor PE. The jogging bottoms do not need a logo on them but must be blue or black. If a hoodie has not been purchased, children may wear their school jumper or cardigan. The standard PE kit still remains as plain white, round neck t-shirt and plain navy shorts or skirt and PE pumps. We do not allow skorts or cullotes, colourful leggings, etc. Please refer to our uniform policy for more detailed information.

# **Individual Photographs**

Tempest Photography will be in school to take the children's individual photographs on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September. Children with siblings in school will have the chance to have their photograph taken together. Those parents who wish to have their children's photograph taken with a younger sibling who does not attend school should come to school at 8:30am to have it taken.

#### **Parental Consent**

We need you to agree or disagree to a large number of things that we do in school. The consents tick list can be found online on our Parent Portal. To sign into this go to <a href="https://kennington.uk.arbor.sc/">https://kennington.uk.arbor.sc/</a> If you have never signed in click 'First Time Logging in?' and follow the instructions for setting up a user name and password and linking to your child or children. Click the green Student Profile button on the left hand side. You will see all the consents in brown that need addressing. Click each one and either consent or decline.

### **School Uniform**

There are just a small minority of children wearing incorrect school uniform at the moment. I know that there have been supply chain issues but just a reminder that it is Autumn/Winter uniform now. Short sleeved shirt/blouse, jumper, cardigan (with school badge), tie, grey shorts/trousers, grey skirt/pinafore, white socks or grey/black tights (girls), grey

socks (boys). Girls may wear grey school trousers. Please refer to the uniform page on the website if unsure.

# **Earrings**

I have noticed a more than usual number of girls with earrings in at the start of this term. Earrings are not part of the school uniform policy and should not be worn. We always suggest having ears pierced at the beginning of the school's six week holidays then they can be worn constantly before being removed on our return. We will be stocking a small supply of earring spacers which are transparent and can be used to keep the hole open. These can be purchased in pairs for a small cost. Alternatively, they can be purchased from online suppliers. We do not provide tape to go over the earrings.

#### Clubs



After school activity clubs run by staff for different age groups will start up again soon. Permission slips will be available via Parent Apps shortly. Most will be on a first come first served

basis depending on limits on numbers. Pick up points will be included in the information.

#### **Halal Meat**

Although we do not serve Halal meat as an option at lunchtime, there is always a vegetarian option available (Quorn). We take the utmost care when serving our children and always ensure they are served the appropriate food. Sometimes the menu may say something like sausages but
