## **Attendance Matters**

Our attendance figures have obviously been seriously affected by Covid-19 and the guidance still says that if your child tests positive, then they isolate. It is however important for us to monitor so we can help support those families who may be struggling to maintain regular attendance at school. We have returned to our system of sending out letters about attendance after each term to those who are in danger of being classed as a Persistent Absentee (10% or more absences). If we see a continuing pattern of absence we will invite parents in to school to discuss strategies to improve attendance. We also monitor the number of times a child is late (after the gates close) as punctuality is an important habit to get into from an early age. **PLEASE BE AWARE THAT CHILDREN SHOULD BE IN SCHOOL NO LATER THAN 8:45am.** The local authority has now resumed issuing Penalty Notices for unauthorised absences of 5 days or more. Family holidays/trips overseas will rarely be authorised.
