Parents Evening will be a good opportunity to discuss the Pupil Information Sheets we sent out this week. They are a quick snap shot of children's progress in response to parent feedback about being more informed of their child's progress throughout the year. Please bear in mind that all the children have had disruption to their education for the

past two years. In fact, some children will not yet have done a full year in school! All the staff are working flat out to not only teach the current curriculum but also plug gaps that have occurred since the pandemic began.

Covid -19

We are currently operating under our Outbreak Plan due to the number of positive cases we have had in one class and also across the school. This has also affected our staffing levels. Fortuately, we have been able to keep all classes open. I am in constant contact with Public Health Lancashire and reviewing the situation on a daily basis. The numbers still remain pretty much the same as they did at the end of last week however we don't have as many in a single class. I will be reviewing the situation on Monday to see if we can step down from the outbreak plan. It would be wise to test your children on Sunday evening before school on Monday. This is purely voluntary but does help us to stop the staff from contracting it and therefore potentially having to close classes if they can't be staffed.
