English Reading

For the first half term the children will be continuing with their retrieval skills using different techniques to help support answering these question types and having a focus on fluency.

Children will then move through looking at different texts to help support with inference and vocabulary style questions

English Writing

The text we will be focusing on in our writing lessons is 'Greek Myths by Jean Menzies. The main writing outcome of this unit will be an adventure story. During the unit children will also focus on the following grammar and punctuation:

- Capital letters and full stops
- Expended noun phrases
- Using paragraphs
- Use prepositions, conjunctions and adverbs to express time, place and cause
- Group related ideas into paragraphs (Y3)
- Use past and present tenses correctly and consistently including the present perfect tense

Maths

In Maths this half term children will start with a unit on addition and subtraction. They will look at building and partitioning numbers and understanding how to use written methods to help with working out and also how to use practically equipment to help support this

They will also start their unit on multiplication where they will be starting to learn to use a formal written methods for these calculations. They will also look at solving multi-step word problems.

<u>Science</u>

In science children will complete a unit of work on Light. They will be learning about different types of light sources. They will also investigate how light travels and how shadows are created.
