PHSE

Theme for this half term in PHSE is economic wellbeing

English Reading

For the spring half term, the children will be continuing with their retrieval skills using different techniques to help support answering these question types and having a focus on fluency.

Children will then move through looking at different texts to help support with inference and vocabulary style questions

English Writing

The text we will be focusing on in our writing lessons is 'Our Tower by Joseph Coelho'. The main writing outcome of this unit will be to write the adventure as a journal from the point of view of one of the children- a retelling in 1st person.

- Capital letters and full stops
- Expended noun phrases
- Using paragraphs
- Use prepositions, conjunctions and adverbs to express time, place and cause
- Group related ideas into paragraphs (Y3)
- Use past and present tenses correctly and consistently including the present perfect tense

Maths

In Maths this half term children will start with a unit on multiplication where they will be starting to learn to use a formal written methods for these calculations. They will also look at solving multistep word problems.

They will also start their unit on length and perimeter learning how to measure and compare different units of measurement whilst also counting the perimeter of a shape or area.

<u>Science</u>

In science children will complete a unit of work on Animals including humans. They will be learning about the animal and human anthology including skeletons and digestive systems.

<u>Music</u>

In music children will be learning about the style Ballads and how this has evolved overtime

Computing

In Computing children will be completing a unit about Programming Scratch

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about coastal processes and landforms. They will learn what a coastline is, why waves are important and how transportation and deposition help in the creation of coastlines. They will then begin to identify coastal landforms such as headlands, and how erosion can create more unusual landforms from headlands such as stacks, arches, and caves.

<u>History</u>

In history this half term children will be learning about Roman Britian, children will learn about Caesar and his failed attempts at invading Britain, and how Claudius successfully achieved this. They will then learn about Caratacus and how he battled the Roman army in Britian. Children will then learn about Boudicca and the Iceni tribe

IN RE, children will be learning about Life and Teachings of Jesus
