PΕ

Our topics in PE this half term are gymnastics and fitness. In this, we will be learning the fundamental skills of moving around to create sequences and the importance of staying fit and healthy

English Reading

For the first half term the children will be continuing with Essential Letters and Sounds phonics, reading practice sessions alongside daily reading lessons 4 times per week. During these reading sessions, children will access a variety of texts which focuses on key vocabulary and progressing onto answering retrieval and inference style questions. In phonics, children will continue to build and revise their phonic knowledge and use this to decode and read books matched to their phonics learning.

Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on 'people and their pets'. They will be learning about different habitats and how these have been adapted for the needs of pets in our home. We will also look at how to properly care for pets and why this is important to their health and wellbeing.

History

In history this half term children will be learning about life in Stuart England. They will learn about the Great Plague and how it affected people in London. They will learn about the Great Fire of London. They will also learn about how and where it started and why it was so devastating.

Class: Foxes

English Writing

The text we will be focusing on in our writing lessons is 'Troll Swap' by Leigh Hodkinson. The main writing outcome of this unit will be an adventure story. During the unit children will also focus on the following grammar and punctuation:

- Capital letters and full stops
- Expended noun phrases
- Using 'because' and 'and for subordination.



Music

In music children will be learning the song 'Tony Chestnut' which focuses on beat, rhythm, melody, echo, call-and-response.

Computing

In Computing children will be completing a unit about programming. This unit will use beebots to teach the basic skills of programming and algorithms.

RE

IN RE, children will be learning about 'Rules and Routines'. In this unit, we will focus on why rules and routines are important and how these can differ for everyone.

Spanish

In this unit pupils will learn numbers to 10 and the names of 10 colours.

PHSE

PHSE is 'Family and Relationships'. We will be Exploring how families can be different, the characteristics and impact of positive relationships. This will also include Looking at conventions of manners and developing an understanding of self-respect

Maths

In Maths this half term children will start with a unit on Place Value to 100. They will look at building and partitioning numbers and fully understanding how they are made up and the value of each digit in these numbers. They will also start their unit on addition and subtraction where they will be starting to learn to use a formal written methods for these calculations. They will also look at solving multi-step word problems.

<u>Geography</u>

In geography this half term, children will be learning about what it is like to live in the mountains. They will complete a study on Keswick in the lake district, Learning about what it is like to live there focusing on transport and tourism.

Design and Technology or Art and Design

In Design and Technology, the children will be completing a unit on structures. They will be looking at what 3D shapes are strong and stable and would make good structures. They will be designing and making a chair for Baby Bear from Goldilocks and the Three Bears.
