#### PHSF

This half term in PHSE is 'Healthy Relationships.' Its about family and people who are special to us.

## English Reading

In EYFS, we will begin with Essential Letters and Sounds phonics, reading practice sessions.

During these sessions children will build up from phase one phonics, listening and attention games in the Nursery, thinking about rhyme and alliteration. In Reception children will begin Phase 2 phonics and begin to decode, orally blend, and segment, ready to start reading CVC words- this is the start of their reading journey.

# English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'We're going to find the Monster' by Malorie Blackman'. The main writing outcome of this unit will be labelling and list writing. During the unit children will also focus on a range of new vocabulary associated with adventures.

In the Nursery, children will be familiar with the text and will

Make marks associated with their learning around adventures.

#### Maths

In Maths this half term children will start to think about number and shape. They will think about numerals and in the Nursery they will start to experiment with making marks. They will understand position thorough words alone and will select shapes appropriately. Children will learn to subitise up to 3.

In Reception, children will match numerals to quantity, thinking of one more and one less. They will learn to subitise to 5 and will start to develop the skill to create patterns of their own.

# Understanding the world-Science

In science, children will learn about themselves. They will think about their five senses and will explore the world around them by using them. Children will work scientifically to conduct simple experiments with colours, make shadows and will also experiment with simple forces such as push and pull.

## <u>Music</u>

In music children will focus: timbre, beat, pitch contour. They will make up new words and explore making sound with voices and use percussion instruments.

## Computing

In Computing children will be practically thinking about staying safe online using the text Chicken Clicking.

## Understanding the world- Geography

Children will be learning about the area in which they live. They will think about maps and what they recognise locally. They will know that there are different countries in the world and will think about similarities and difference

Children will begin to think about seasonal change.

# <u>History</u>

In history this half term children will be learning about life in the past. They will think about the life of their grandparents and begin to make sense of their own life-story. They will learn the difference between their self now and when they were a baby. Children will think about the history of bears.

#### RE

IN RE, children will be learning about celebrations for different religions such as

#### Spanish

In this unit pupils will learn about simple greetings in Spanish. They will learn to say hello to their friends.

## Design and Technology or Art and Design

In Design and Technology, the children will be completing a unit on mark making. Children will use different artistic medias to create marks and give meaning to them. We will think about how to prepare for art and how to design with some degree of independence.
