Class : Nursery

PHSE

Nursery will be learning about a new feeling each week, to gain an understanding of their own feelings and emotions and how others may feel.

English Reading

In EYFS, we will begin with Essential Letters and Sounds phonics, reading practice sessions.

During these sessions children will continue with phase one phonics, listening and attention games in the Nursery, and continue to practice oral blending. Children will become more fluent in oral blending words and will hear and identify initial sounds.

Children will recognise their name and be able to tap a beat and hear alliteration and rhyme in words.

English Writing

In the Nursery, children will continue to learn more familiar stories and be able to recall what happened. We will also explore Winter non-fiction texts and stories relating to our topic and will make marks associated with their learning around the season. The children will be encouraged to make purposeful marks that they can explain.

Children in the Nursery will begin to write/ trace their name daily as a morning task or make marks freely. They will also have guided support to form their letters correctly.

Maths

In Maths children will learn about numbers 1-10. Nursery will begin counting with touch and knowing one touch is another one and how many left is the final number. They will learn subitising to 5 in Nursery and begin to form numerals correctly.

Children will think about numerals and they will start to experiment with number composition. They will consolidate their learning of subitising to 3 in Nursery and begin to form numerals correctly.

Understanding the world- Science

In Science, children will learn about seasonal change (focus Winter) and our new focus is Polar Regions. We will continue to use our senses to look at the natural world around us as we go on winter walks together.

As our topic is Brrr... its chilly. We will learn about different animals in the Polar Regions and their habitats and how we can help our animals to survive the winter.

Music

In Music, Nursery will be exploring new music relating to Chinese New Year and how it may be different to other music they have listened to before. They will also be exploring how they can use their voice to make higher or lower pitches.

Computing

In Computing, children will be using the interactive whiteboard to find things out together and to understand the importance of being safe.

Understanding the world- Geography

Children will be learning about Chinese New Year and how understanding how it is celebrated. Our main topic is Brrr... its chilly- where we will look at the features of different continents in relation to ours. We will learn about different countries in the Winter and look at the map to find polar regions.

History

In History, Nursery will touch upon the History of Chinese New Year and the culture in China. We will explore the history of the country and the similarities and differences between celebrations now and then.

RE

This half term we will think about religions and cultures around the world as we think about Chinese New Year.

Spanish

In this unit pupils will learn about simple greetings in Spanish. They will learn to say hello to their friends.

Design and Technology or Art and Design

In Nursery, we will explore different materials and how they can keep us warm during the winter. We will also design and construct our own Winter shelters.

In expressive arts- Nursery will be dressing as their chosen Polar animal and becoming the animal by showing how they walk, their noise etc.
