

PE

In PE, the children will continue to develop their balancing skills focusing on stairs to use alternative feet when using them. We will also use a range of equipment so children can match the skill to the task.

English Reading

In EYFS, we will begin with Essential Letters and Sounds phonics, reading practice sessions.

During these sessions children will continue with phase one phonics, listening and attention games in the Nursery, and continue to practice oral blending. Children will become more fluent in oral blending words and will here and identify initial sounds. Children this half term will begin to develop their listening awareness of the phonemes for the single letter sounds.

Children will continue to recognise their name daily and incorporate more rhyming in their daily routines to strengthen their understanding of rhyme.

Understanding the world- Science

In Science, children will learn about life cycles of plants and butterflies. We will be planting our own plants in the outdoor area, we will also have our own caterpillars that will turn into butterflies which the children will be able to observe both to see them grow over the weeks. This is a great way for children to actively see how life cycles work and embed their amazing learning!

PHSE

Nursery will continue to learn about feelings as we dive into a new social story each week as we will discuss how others may feel and how we should respond. One story focus will be 'something else' as we will understand how someone else may feel in that situation.



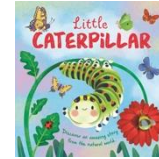
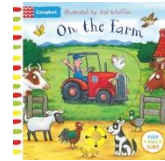
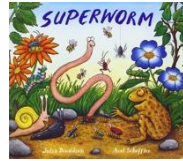
Curriculum Map - Spring 2



Class : Nursery

English Writing

In the Nursery, we will also explore a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and stories relating to our topic and will make marks associated with their learning around animals and plants. The children will be encouraged to make purposeful marks that they can explain. Children will begin to be encouraged to speak about the story or what happens as a stimulus to develop longer sentences.



Children in the Nursery will continue to write/ trace their name daily as a morning task or make marks freely. They will also have guided support to form their letters correctly. Children will use the writing area to make marks freely, developing pre-writing shapes or letter formation using a range of equipment to support a good pencil grip.

Music

In Music, Nursery will be exploring new sounds relating to the farm, creating sounds of a range of animals and other environmental sounds. The children will also learn a new song weekly relating to the week's focus.

Computing

In Computing children will be using the interactive whiteboard to find things out together and to understand the importance of being safe.

RE

This half term we will focus on Easter as we learn about the celebration and how it may be similar or different to other celebrations we know of.

Spanish

The children will continue to learn simple greetings in Spanish this will also be used when taking the register as children will learn to say hello.

History

In History, Nursery will touch upon the history of Easter and how it can be celebrated. We will explore the similarities and differences between celebrations now and then.

Maths

In Maths children will learn about numbers 1-10. Nursery will begin counting with touch and knowing one touch is another one and how many is the final number counted. They will learn subitising to 5 in Nursery and begin to form numerals correctly.

Children will think about numerals and they will start to experiment with number composition. They will consolidate their learning of subitising to 3 in Nursery and begin to form numerals correctly.

In Nursery we are focusing on repeating patterns and describing them. We will also be comparing, size and length of flowers and insects.

Understanding the world- Geography

In Geography, We will observe where farms are - countryside or city? We will share the similarities and differences we observe looking at different farms and how they look. We will discuss that different foods and plants come from different countries.

Design and Technology or Art and Design

In Nursery, we will explore different patterns and exploring different materials and ways to create them. We will look at butterflies and flowers to support our pattern making.

Part of global recycling day, children will take part in junk modelling making as they will create their own model using a range of recycle materials. This allows children to express their imagination and explore different materials.
