

PE

Topics for PE this half term are dance and gymnastics.

English Reading

This half term we will spend 2 weeks studying each of the following texts; The Boy at the Back of the Class, Street Child and The Girl of Ink and Stars.

We will use these books to learn new vocabulary and develop our reading skills of inference, retrieval, prediction and summarising.

Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on Living things and their habitats: the classification code. We will study what classification is and why we classify living organisms. We will also learn the different levels of classification and naming of species. As a class we will also get outside and look to classify the animals and plants we have in our surrounding area.

History

This unit children will learn about Christianity in Three Empires. We will focus on three cities: Rome, Constantinople and Adulis (in the African empire of Aksum), representing three types of Christianity (connected but different) influenced by and influencing local culture. Stories examine the role of rulers in the spread of Christianity.



Curriculum Map - Spring 2

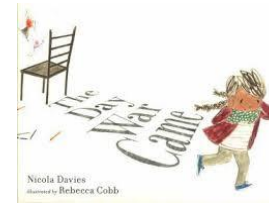

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'The Selfish Giant' by Nicola Davies. The main writing outcome of this unit will be to write a letter highlighting the plight of refugees. During the unit children will also focus on developing the following skills.

- Building vocabulary
- Evaluating authors' language choices
- Analysing and comparing text examples
- Taking part in group discussions and debates
- Integrating dialogue to convey character and Advance the action
- Planning a letter



Music

In music we will be producing a composition to represent the festival of colour (Holi festival)

Computing

In Computing children will be completing a unit on data handling.

RE

IN RE children will be learning about the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Spanish

In this unit pupils will learn vocabulary, phrases and sentences on The Olympics

PHSE

The theme for this half term in PHSE is citizenship. Recognising the role that pressure groups play in society; learning about the value of a diverse community; considering how our food choices affect the environment; understanding how to show care and concern to others; considering how rights and responsibilities are linked; learning about how parliament works. .

Maths

In Maths this half term children will be studying fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also be developing our arithmetic and reasoning abilities as well as focusing on our doubling and times table knowledge.

They will also complete units on perimeter and area, statistics and shape.

Geography

In this unit, children will learn about tourism. We will study what tourism is, the various types that exist and how it alters from location to location. We will also be looking at the impact, both positive and negative, of tourism to a given area. We will use Llandudno, The Alps and Southern Spain as case studies.

Art and Design

Children explore creative photographic techniques, creating new images through photomontage, understanding photorealistic self-portraits, and applying digital photography to art design, enhancing their skills in composition and editing.
