Initiative	Doing things without being told; you find out what you need to know; you keep going when things get tough; and you spot and take advantage of opportunities that others pass by. You act, instead of reacting. Communication	The art of sharing meaningful information with others.	 Perform music/compositions to others Performing your drama piece to others Giving constructive feedback on performance Motivating your ensemble Encouraging someone who is less confident Discussing ways to improve an ensemble performance Sharing ideas with a group
