1. Whole School Strategies

Students are provided with a 1:1 iPad device to support engagement in learning and homework. This includes access to subject specific applications and content that is conducive to effective study.

An effective and impactful homework club encourages the completion of independent work through a teaching assistant led provision at break and lunchtimes.

Attendance initiatives to support student attendance to school and reduce absence. These include rewards for good attendance and improved attendance.

Attendance clinics and coffee mornings for the hardest to reach families.

2. Targeted Support

Access tutoring staff to provide a programme for extra support in English and Maths. The focus, disadvantaged students, with a laser focus upon Year 11 students.

Where applicable, financial support for the most disadvantaged for participation in educational visits, extracurricular events, and music lessons.

Support for SEND students in all year groups through using a tutor to close the literacy and numeracy gaps.

SEND Emotional Coaching delivered by VIP education, to support the most vulnerable learners.

A revision hub that is available before and after school to support engagement in preparation for assessments and examinations.

3. Numeracy

Maths intervention is in place to encourage a greater depth of mathematical understanding around key subject specific skills. Numeracy levels are monitored and interventions are targeted.

4. Literacy

The reading and literacy strategy is effective in supporting students with access to texts through the reading room provision. Reading levels are monitored and interventions have an impact.
