Core Value	Meaning	Examples
<b>Leadership</b>	The ability of an individual or a group of individuals to influence and guide followers towards a common goal.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learners in Spanish often work in pairs and groups to communicate together. Leadership is encouraged to ensure all learners can perform to the best of their abilities.</li> <li>Leading those conversations and discussions.</li> </ul>
<b>Organisation</b>	The way in which something is done or arranged.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Being able to locate the correct resources on iPad to complete the lesson</li> <li>Being able to complete homework on time.</li> <li>Homework often requires a series of tasks which students have to manage their own time to complete.</li> <li>Ensuring you are fully equipped for the lesson.</li> </ul>
<b>Resilience</b>	The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When faced with a challenging skill, not giving up and mastering it.</li> <li>When working in a pair or group of peers who you may not know or get on with, the ability to complete the task regardless.</li> <li>Coping with nerves of speaking Spanish and overcoming these to perform.</li> </ul>
<b>Initiative</b>	Doing things without being told; you find out what you need to know; you keep going when things get tough; and you spot and take advantage of opportunities that others pass by. You act, instead of reacting.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Completing engage task and getting sorted at the start of the lesson without being told.</li> <li>Helping others who are struggling with an activity.</li> <li>Encouraging others who are struggling or nervous.</li> <li>Using online resources to work independently at your level.</li> </ul>
<b>Communication</b>	The art of sharing meaningful information with others.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Having a conversation, including skills when you get stuck.</li> <li>Practicing intonation, fluency and spontaneity in the role of conversation.</li> <li>Role play practice in different common situations.</li> <li>Communicating in the written form: expanding your answers, describing a photo.</li> <li>Encouraging someone who is less confident.</li> </ul>
