Core Value	Meaning	Examples
Leadership	The ability of an individual or a group of individuals to influence and guide followers towards a common goal.	 Become a Specialist during activities to support your peers. Show leadership qualities to motivate your team during group activities. Recognise strengths in yourself and peers to ensure group work tasks are shared out appropriately.
Organisation	The way in which something is done or arranged.	 Ensuring you have the correct equipment (SMART START, iPad) Get to lessons on time Organising your online folders and work appropriately and effectively. Organising thoughts and opinions logically when writing.
Resilience	The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties.	 Having an open mind when faced with challenging concepts. Coping with failure and trying again. Responding positively to constructive comments. Having high expectations of effort and presentation.
Initiative	Doing things without being told; you find out what you need to know; you keep going when things get tough; and you spot and take advantage of opportunities that others pass by. You act, instead of reacting.	 Showing confidence in your own opinions and being able to articulate these. Independently researching concepts and ideas to gain a more informed opinion. Identifying key students to look for support.
Communication	The art of sharing meaningful information with others.	 Skill share with other students. Encouraging other students during new or difficult activities. Articulating opinions confidently .
