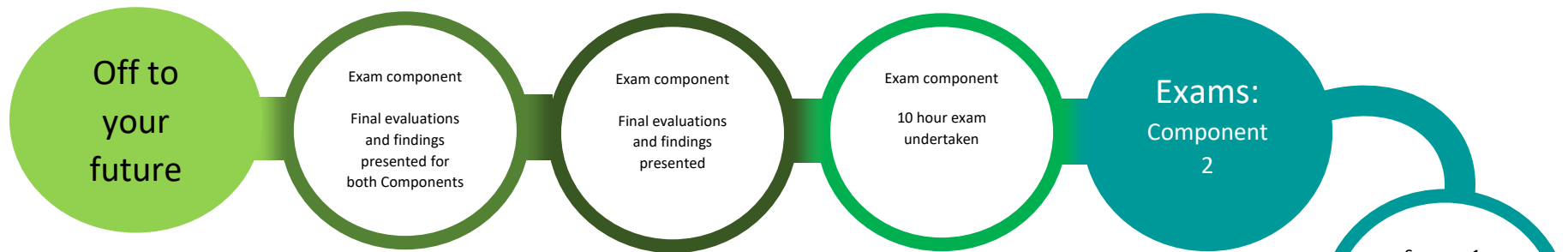

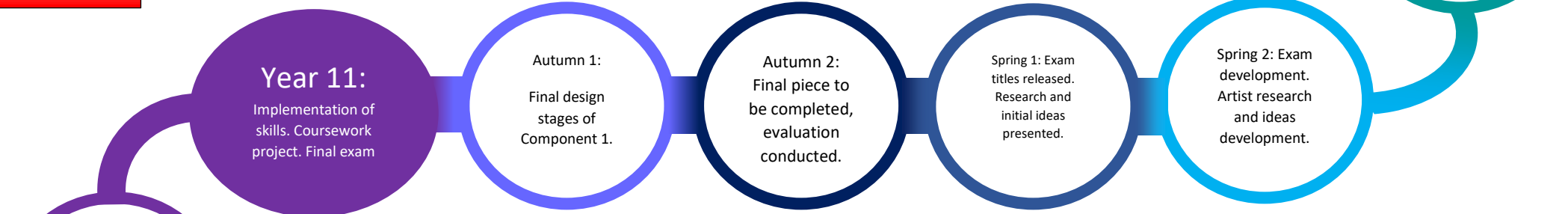
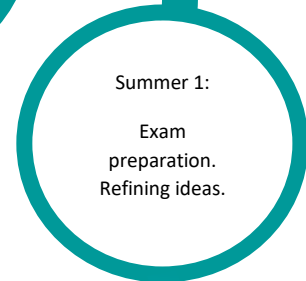


Topic overview

Developed ideas are refined into a final piece design. Students will have time to prepare materials ready for their 10 hour exam.

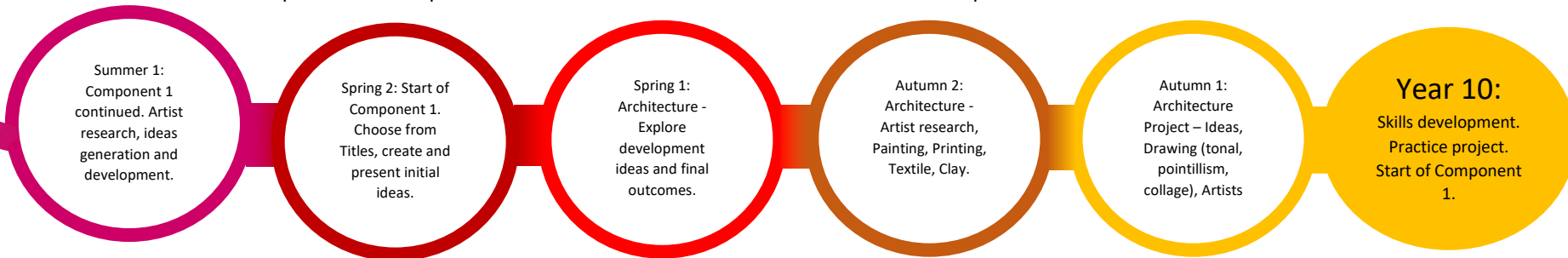
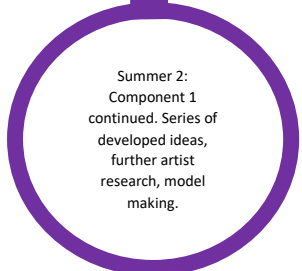


Topic overview

Ideas should now have been developed ready to be refined and tested. Final piece designed with tests informing final decisions. Final piece to be completed and evaluated.

Topic overview

Component 2 begins. Exam starting titles will be chosen from and initial ideas and research presented in sketchbooks. Drawings, material explorations and research inform series of developed ideas.

Development of Component 1 continues. Artist research will inform project direction and all ideas will presented artistically within their sketchbooks.

Topic overview

Introduction to the course Components. Practice project will simulate the research and ideas development they will need to undertake during their Component 1. Outcome in clay to further develop their material knowledge. Begin major coursework project Component 1.
