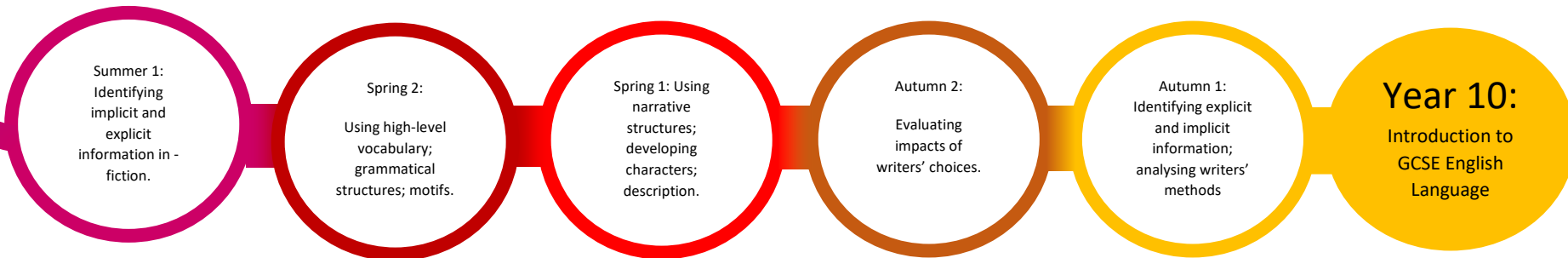


**Comparing viewpoints and perspectives**

Language paper 2, Section A: students will read extracts based on a range of themes and ideas, such as education, climate and world exploration.

**Writing non-fiction texts**

Language paper 2, Section B: students will develop skills in writing to express a viewpoint.



**Reading non-fiction texts**

Language paper 2, section A: students will read a wide range of non-fiction texts, such as letters, essays, articles, on a wide range of ideas and viewpoints. Texts will be selected from 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century

**Writing creative texts**

Language paper 1, Section B: students will develop skills in creative writing by exploring examples and purposeful practice.

**Reading creative texts**

Language Paper 1, Section A: students will read a wide range of 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century texts. They will develop reading skills, such as analysis of writers methods and evaluating impacts.
