Jewellery and Uniform

We are seeing an increase in the number of children wearing bracelets and hooped earrings. These are not part of any school uniform code for health and safety reasons.

The Association of PE (AfPE) states:

The reason not to wear earrings (or any jewellery) is that it can lead to injury for the wearer and for others in the class and it is the teacher's duty of care that must apply here. The reason is both about tearing of the ear lobe, but also the post of the earring going into the neck which is where the brachial nerve is running directly to the brain.

Similarly, we are still seeing a large number of children coming into school wearing the wrong uniform including trainers. These are not suitable footwear for anything other than P.E.

Please can you ensure that children are wearing the appropriate uniform. We will be sending home letters to parents / carers when children are consistently wearing the incorrect uniform.

Thank you to those of you have made the effort to ensure your child is wearing the right uniform.

Lost Books - Amnesty

We know that books often get lost at home. Before we buy new ones, please could you look at home and drop into school any that belong to us. Thank you!

As of this year and, in line with other schools, we will be charging parents a standard rate of £5 for any book that is taken home and not returned or comes back in a state of disrepair.
