I will be available throughout both evenings.

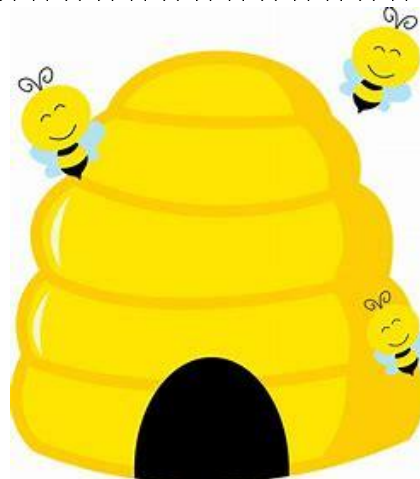
Meetings will take place in your child's classroom. A space outside of the classroom will be available for you to look through your child's books.

Introducing the Hive & the Nest

All of our children at Kingsfield are valued and important members of our whole school community. We are an inclusive school and SEND is an area we are working to improve, with support from The Active Learning Trust.

For some of our children, their significant SEND means that accessing learning in the classroom context all day, every day is not appropriate to meet their needs.



The Hive has been set up as a resourced and active learning hub for times when children learn best in smaller groups and in a practical way.

The Nest is a nurturing provision to support regulation, emotional and physical development in a calm, safe and positive space.



Both provisions are located in the main school building to provide access to a safe and purposeful outdoor learning area and to ensure that this provision feels part of our whole school community.
