Dear Parents / Carers,

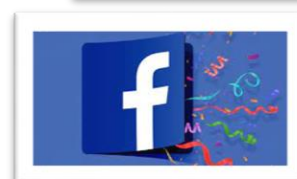
Thank you for all of the donations for the Harvest Festival that Key Stage 2 children attended at our local church. The children were well-behaved and enjoyed visiting the church.
