Dear Parents / Carers,

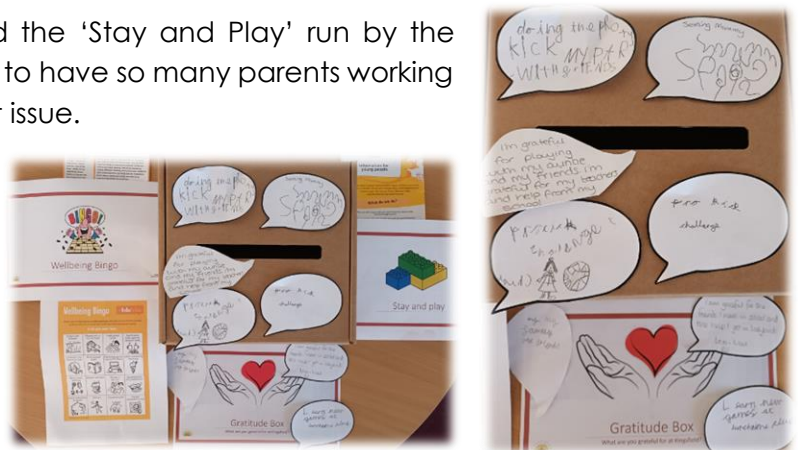

At the last check we have raised a massive £1,823; 40% of the proceeds will come to the school and 60% will be going to charity supporting children with life-limiting conditions to have sporting experiences. 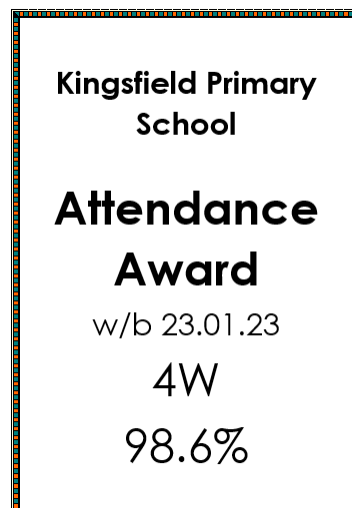
